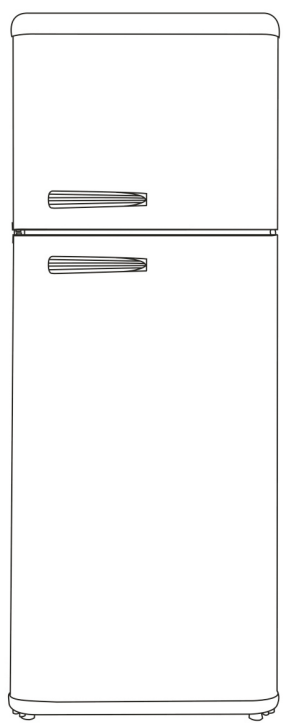

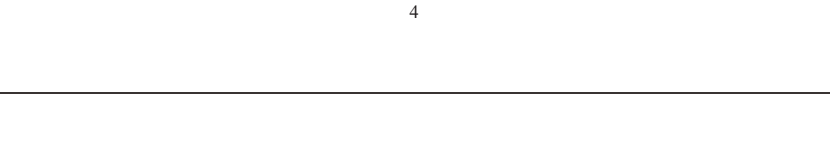

Care and Maintenance

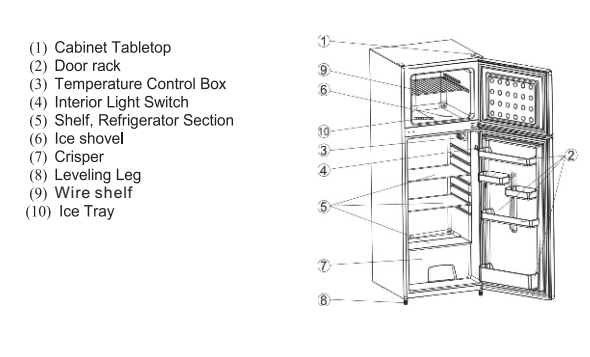

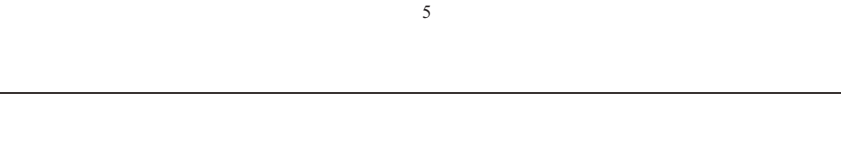

Operating Your Refrigerator

- Temperature Settings
Your refrigerator has one control for regulating the temperature. The temperature control is located on the top center of the refrigerator compartment.
The first time you turn the unit on, adjust the temperature control knob to "5" and run for at least 1 hour before putting foods inside.
The range of the refrigerator temperature control is from position "1" (the warmest) to "7" (the coldest).
Turning the temperature control knob to "1" should be appropriate for home or office refrigerator use.
Turning the temperature control knob to "7" position stops the cooling cycle but does not shut the power to the unit.

- The Frost Free Compartment
The frost free compartment is designed for the long-term storage of frozen food.
The storage life of frozen foods varies and the recommended storage time should not be exceeded.
Do not place foods on the air outlet, and leave spaces for airflow.
If you choose to change the thermostat setting, adjust thermostat control by one increment at a time.
After several hours for temperature to stabilize between adjustments.

- How To Defrost
Defrost the freezer compartment when the ice / frost is approximately 1/2" thick or every 3 months, whichever comes first.
Remove all contents from the freezer compartment.
Leave the freezer door open to allow accumulated ice / frost to melt.
Remove large pieces of ice as needed.
Do not use hot water or other electric heating devices to melt the accumulated ice.
After defrosting, remove accumulated ice / water and wipe the freezer compartment dry with a soft cloth.
Place the ice in a non-vulcanized plastic in the freezer compartment, place allow the evaporator located behind the freezer wall to completely defrost for approximately 1 hour before restoring the unit.
How To Change the Interior Light
NOTE: All parts enclosed must be saved to do the installation of the light bulb.
Remove the lamp cover by unscrewing.
Insert the new bulb into the socket.
Replace the new bulb of the same voltage and wattage.
Re-install the lamp cover by screwing.

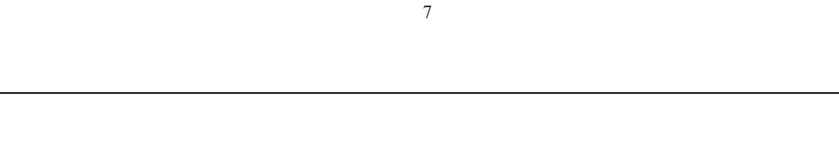

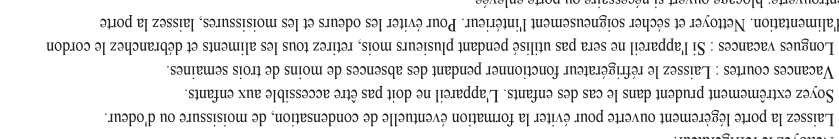

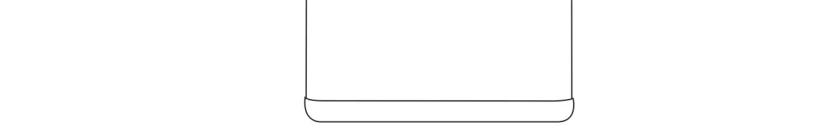
