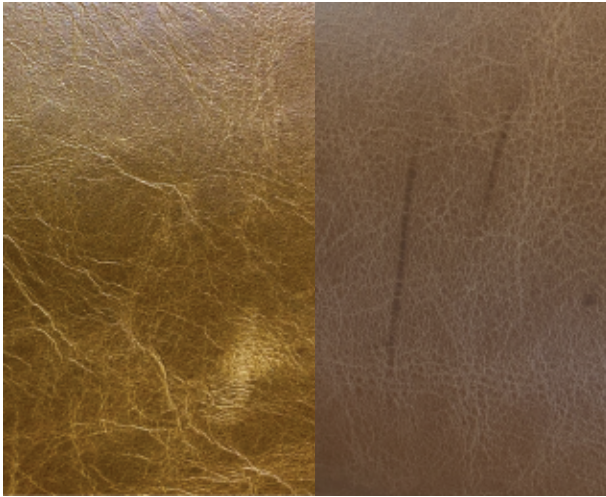
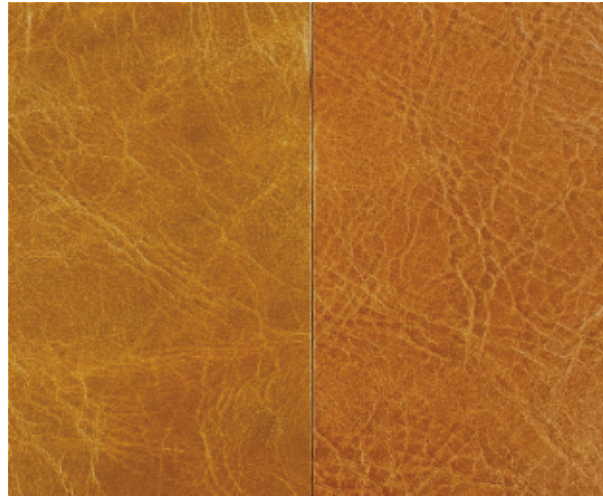


Gus* Natural Leather Overview



Natural Characteristics

Wrinkles, grain patterns, scars and markings are all normal characteristics of natural leather. We choose quality hides and use minimal processing which makes each design unique and authentic.



Color Variations

Depending on the grain and texture of each surface on the hide, different areas may vary in saturation and tone. This contrast is normal and adds to the visual depth of the design.



Stretching

Like most leather products, stretching after use is normal. This "working in" of the leather only adds to the comfort, softness and character over time.



Scratches

Scratches from fingernails, pets, buttons etc. are normal and to be expected. This does not effect the durability of the piece and only adds to its visual charm and character over time. If desired, some of these markings can be removed with leather conditioners.



Hide Size

The usable material in a hide is usually much smaller than the actual size of the product it's covering. This is why you'll notice more seams on a leather sofa than on a similar fabric sofa.



Patina

Over time, the oils from your skin, combined with surface wear and fading will give the piece a beautiful, warm, worn-in look. This is the desired effect of using natural, minimally processed leather.
