

JAIPUR WASHABLE AREA RUGS

This area rug is machine washable and was tested for up to 3 washes
Generally, rugs only need spot cleaning and regular vacuuming
Vacuum with low intensity and without a rotary brush
Use the washing machine only if necessary

Although those rugs are machine washable, please consider your washing machine limitations for larger size rugs (6x9 and bigger)
For very large rugs, it is preferred to spot clean and when needed

Remove any labels before putting your rug in the washing machine

Always remove or blot any excess liquid or other dirt from your rug before putting it in the washing machine

Make sure to place your rug having its pile surface facing out

Use a mild detergent (no bleach)

Wash at cold water maximum temperature 30°C (celcius degree) (86 degrees farenheit) and using the 'delicate' washing option.

DRYING :

If possible, dry your rug by hanging or draping it over railing or elevating it indoor or outdoor if the weather permits (away from direct sunlight)
or

You can can tumble dry the rug in your dryer without heat on an air-only cycle.

After washing your rug, It is possible to see small threads pulling out around the side finishings. Simply use a pair of scissors and gently cut any loose thread - Do not pull on threads.

GENERAL SPOT CLEANING TIPS

Treat any stain as quicky as possible .

Blot the area with a paper towel or color-safe cloth to soak up excess liquid

Use a color-safe cloth or sponge and blot the soiled area instead of scrubbing to prevent spreading the stain all over the rug.

Use cold water and mixed with liquid dish soap to try & remove specific stains.
