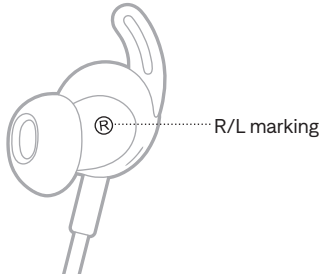
NOTES:

- Medium eartips and large stability wings are attached to the earbuds.
- If any part of your product appears to be missing or damaged, don't use it. Visit support.Bose.com/ncwe for troubleshooting articles, videos, and product repair or replacement.

INSERT THE EARBUD

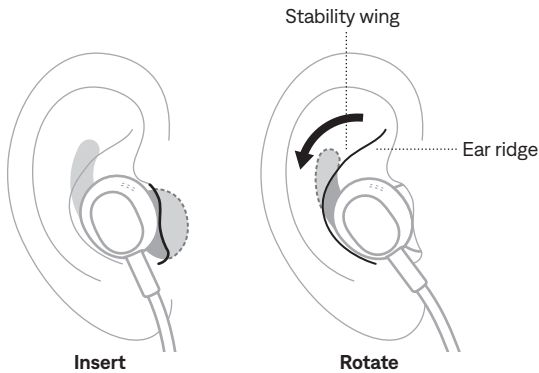
1. Insert the earbud so the eartip gently rests at the opening of your ear canal and the wing fits just under your ear ridge.

NOTE: Each earbud is marked with either an **R** (right) or **L** (left).



2. Slightly rotate the earbud back until the eartip creates a comfortable seal at your ear canal and the stability wing rests under your ear ridge.

NOTE: You may need to rotate the earbud back and forth for the eartip to create a comfortable seal. However, rotating it too far back or forward may impact audio and microphone sound quality.

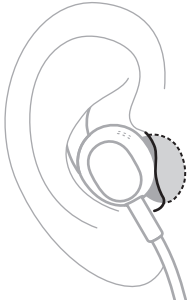
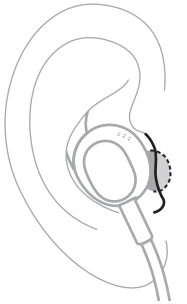


3. Check the fit (see page 10).
4. Repeat steps 1 – 3 to insert the other earbud.

CHECK YOUR FIT

For the best fit, audio performance, and noise cancellation, use a mirror to make sure you're using the correct size eartips and stability wings. You may need to try a different size eartip or wing for each ear.

Eartips

FIT	WHAT TO CHECK
Proper fit	 The eartip gently rests at the opening of your ear canal to create a comfortable seal. Background noise should sound muffled. NOTE: Noise cancellation may impact the ability to hear muffled noise.
Too much pressure	 The eartip feels uncomfortable and squished in your ear canal.
Too loose	 The eartip rests too deep in your ear canal, feels loose in your ear, or falls out when you move your head.

Stability wings

FIT	WHAT TO CHECK
Proper fit	 The wing doesn't stick out or feel squished against your ear ridge.
Too big	 The wing is sticking out or feels squished under your ear ridge.
Too small	 The wing doesn't reach your ear ridge.

TRY ANOTHER SIZE

Wear the earbuds for an extended period of time. If the earbuds don't feel comfortable or secure, or noise cancellation or sound quality isn't as expected, try another size eartip or stability wing.

You may need to try all three eartip or both wing sizes or use a different size eartip or wing for each ear.

Eartips

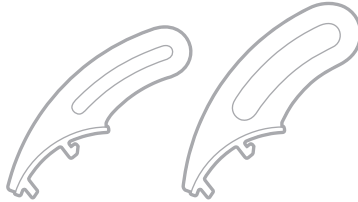
Three sizes of eartips are included with the earbuds: small, medium, and large.



Medium eartips come attached to the earbuds. If they feel too small, try large eartips. If they feel too big, try small eartips.

Stability wings

Two sizes of wings are included with the earbuds: medium and large.

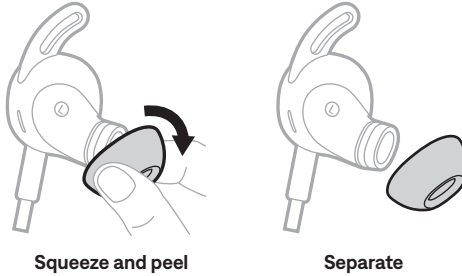


Large wings come attached to the earbuds. If they feel too big, try size medium.

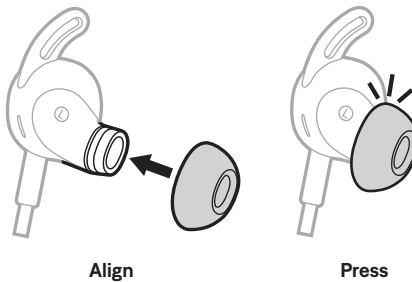
CHANGE THE EARTIPS

1. Holding the earbud, gently squeeze the eartip and peel it away from the earbud.



CAUTION: To prevent tearing, do NOT pull on the edge of the eartip.

2. Choose a new eartip size (see page 10).
3. Align the eartip with the earbud nozzle and press the eartip onto the nozzle until you feel it snap securely into place and hear it click.



4. Repeat steps 1 – 3 for the other earbud, as needed.

NOTE: You may need to use a different size eartip for each ear.

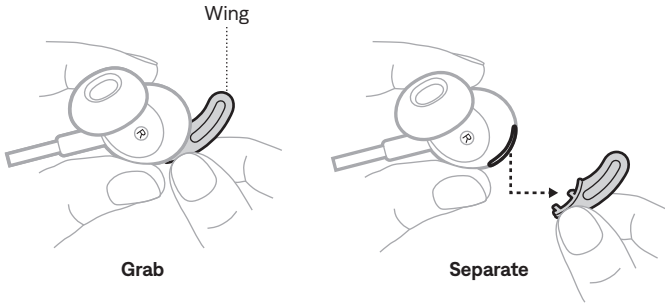
5. Insert the earbuds (see page 9).
6. Check the fit (see page 10).

NOTES:

- If you change the eartip, you may need to change the wing so the wing rests comfortably against your ear ridge (see page 14).

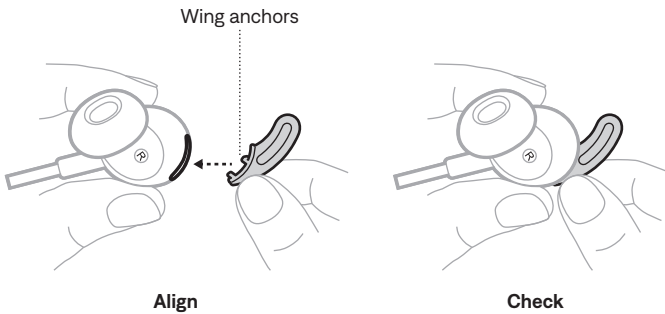
CHANGE THE STABILITY WINGS

1. Holding the earbud, gently grab the base of the wing and peel the wing down and away from the earbud.



CAUTION: To prevent tearing, do NOT pull on the top part of the wing.

2. Choose a new wing size (see page 12).
3. Align the wing with the notch on the top of the earbud.
4. Gently insert the wing anchors into the notch.
5. Press down until the wing fits securely into place, then check for alignment.



6. Repeat steps 1 – 5 for the other wing, as needed.

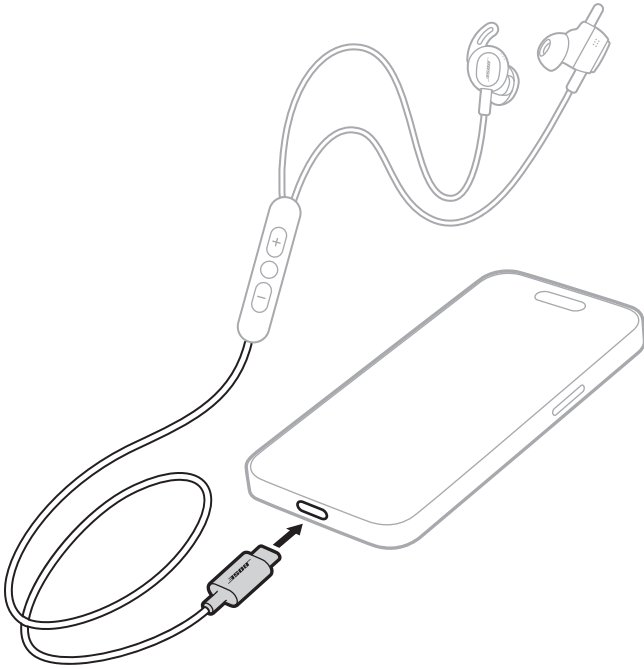
NOTE: You may need to use a different size wing for each ear.

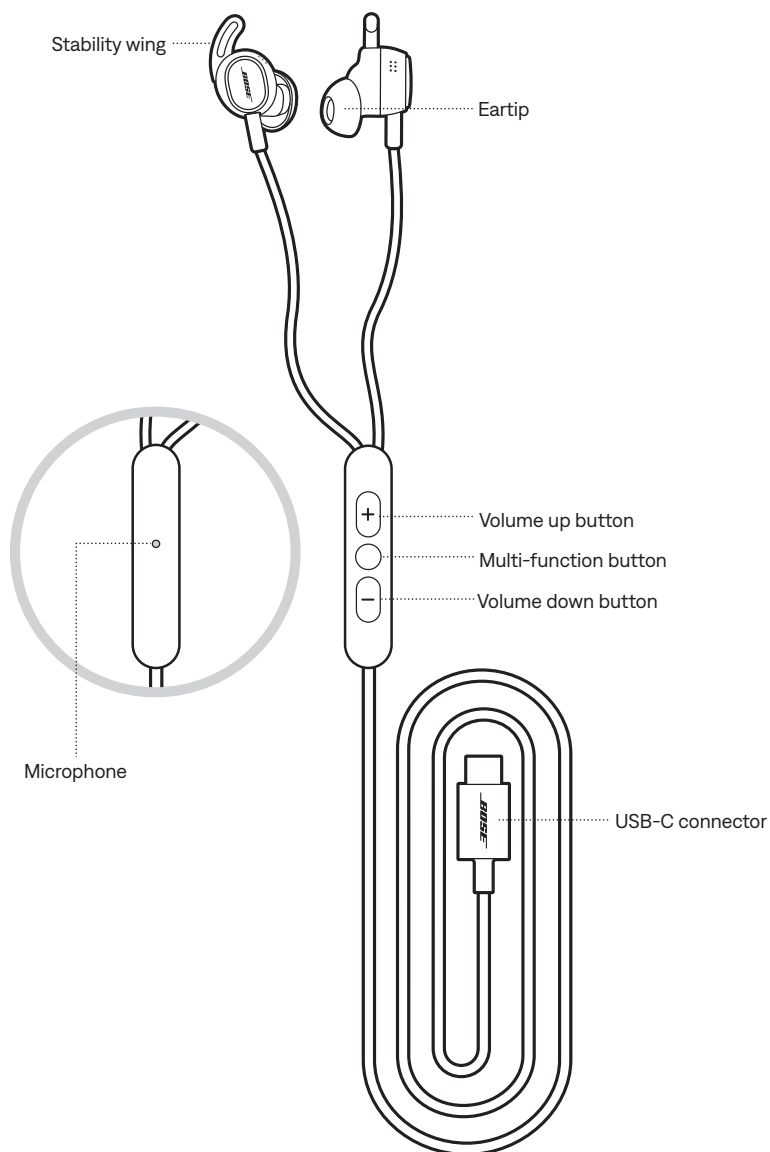

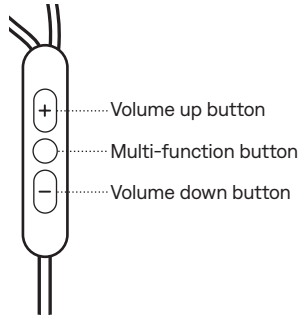

Connect the USB Type-C® connector to the USB-C® port on your device.





The earbud controls are located on the remote below the earbuds. You can play/pause audio, change the volume, perform basic call functions, and change the noise cancellation state.



NOTE: For best audio performance, use the earbuds when the temperature is between 32° F (0° C) and 104° F (40° C).

MEDIA PLAYBACK

CONTROL	WHAT TO DO
Play/Pause	Press the Multi-function button.
Skip forward	Double-press the Multi-function button.
Skip backward	Triple-press the Multi-function button.

VOLUME

CONTROL	WHAT TO DO
Volume up	Press the Volume up button.
Volume down	Press the Volume down button.

PHONE CALLS

CONTROL	WHAT TO DO
Answer a call	Press the Multi-function button.
End/Decline a call	Double-press the Multi-function button.
Answer a second incoming call and put the current call on hold	While on a call and a second incoming call is ringing, press the Multi-function button.
Decline a second incoming call and stay on current call	While on a call and a second incoming call is ringing, double-press the Multi-function button.

NOTE: The microphone is located on the back of the remote. You don't need to hold the remote close to your mouth during phone calls.

NOISE CANCELLATION

CONTROL	WHAT TO DO
Change the noise cancellation state	Press and hold the Multi-function button. NOTE: For more information about noise cancellation states, see page 20.

You can choose between three pre-configured noise cancellation states based on your listening preferences and environment — Quiet, Aware, and Off.

STATE	DESCRIPTION
Quiet	Full noise cancellation with Bose-optimized stereo audio. Allows you to block out distractions using the highest level of noise cancellation.
Aware	Full transparency with Bose-optimized stereo audio. Allows you to hear your surroundings while enjoying your audio in stereo.
Off	No active noise cancellation. Allows you to conserve your connected device's battery life.

NOTE: By default, the earbuds power on in Quiet state out-of-box. Each time they are connected to your device, they power on in the last mode used.

CHANGE THE STATE

1. To change the state, press and hold the Multi-function button.



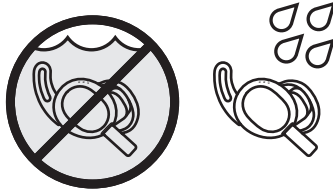
A voice prompt announces each state in a loop.

2. When you hear the name of your preferred state, release the button.

The earbuds are rated IPX4 water resistant. They are designed to be sweat and weather resistant but aren't meant to be submerged under water.

CAUTIONS:

- Do NOT swim or shower with the earbuds.
- Do NOT submerge the earbuds.



NOTES:

- Make sure the USB-C connector is clean and dry before connecting to the USB-C port on your device.
- IPX4 isn't a permanent condition, and resistance might decrease as a result of normal wear.

STORE THE EARBUDS

Place the earbuds in the carry case for easy storage.

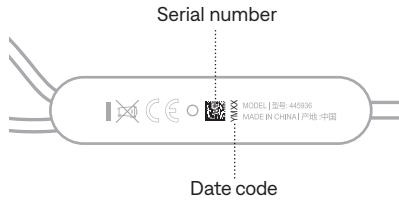
NOTE: Disconnect the earbuds from your device when not in use.

CLEAN THE EARBUDS

COMPONENT	PROCEDURE
Eartips and stability wings	Remove the eartips and wings from the earbuds and gently wash them by hand with a mild detergent and water. CAUTION: Never insert any cleaning tool into the eartips. NOTE: Make sure you thoroughly rinse and dry the eartips and wings before re-attaching them to the earbuds.
Earbud nozzles	Gently wipe the opening of the nozzle only with a dry, soft cotton swab or equivalent. CAUTION: Never insert any cleaning tool into the nozzle.
Microphone	Gently wipe the microphone (see page 17) with a dry, soft cotton cloth.
USB-C connector	Gently wipe the USB-C connector (see page 17) with a dry, soft cotton cloth.
